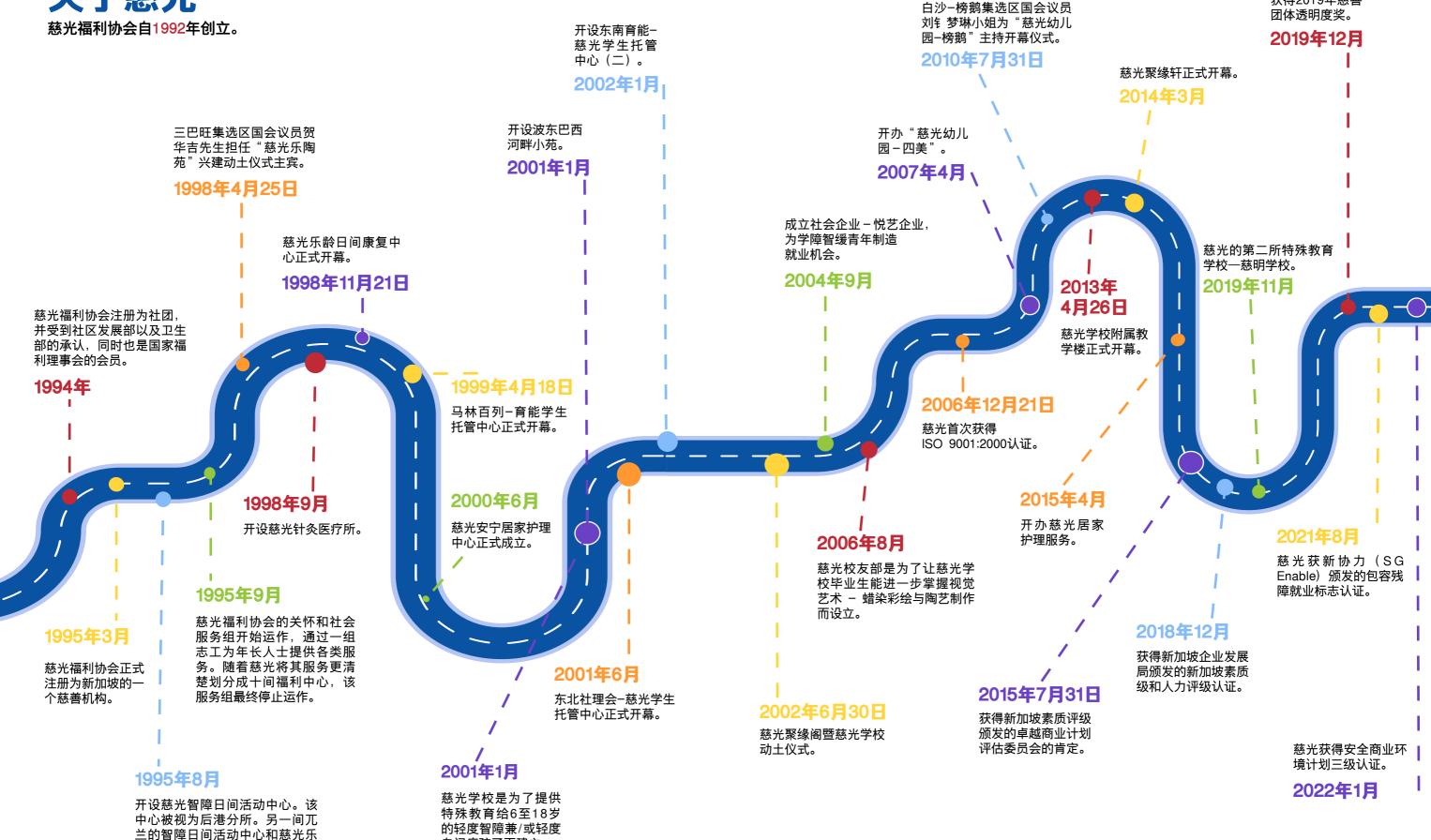

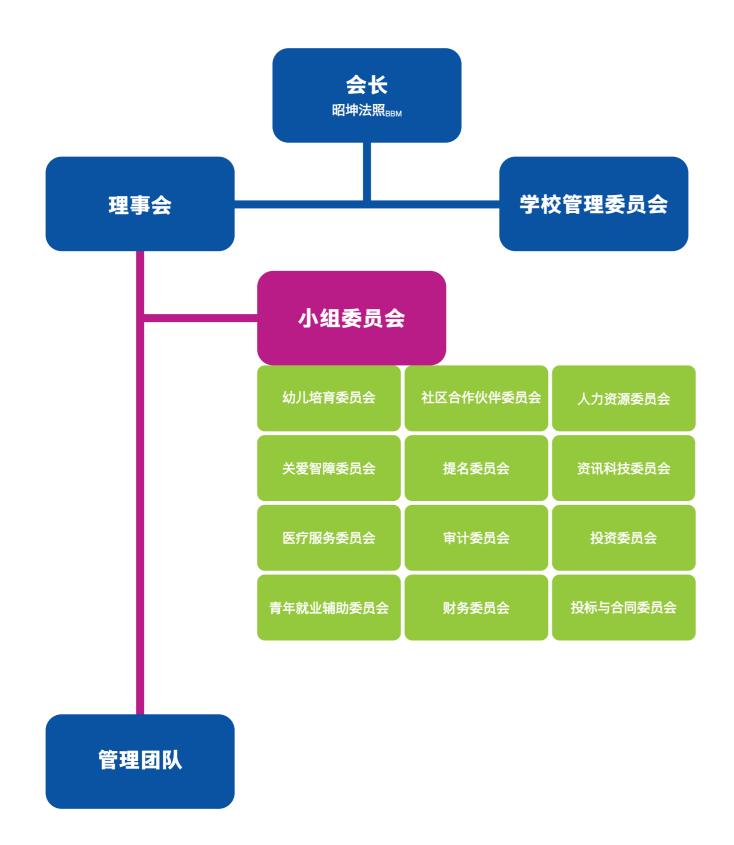

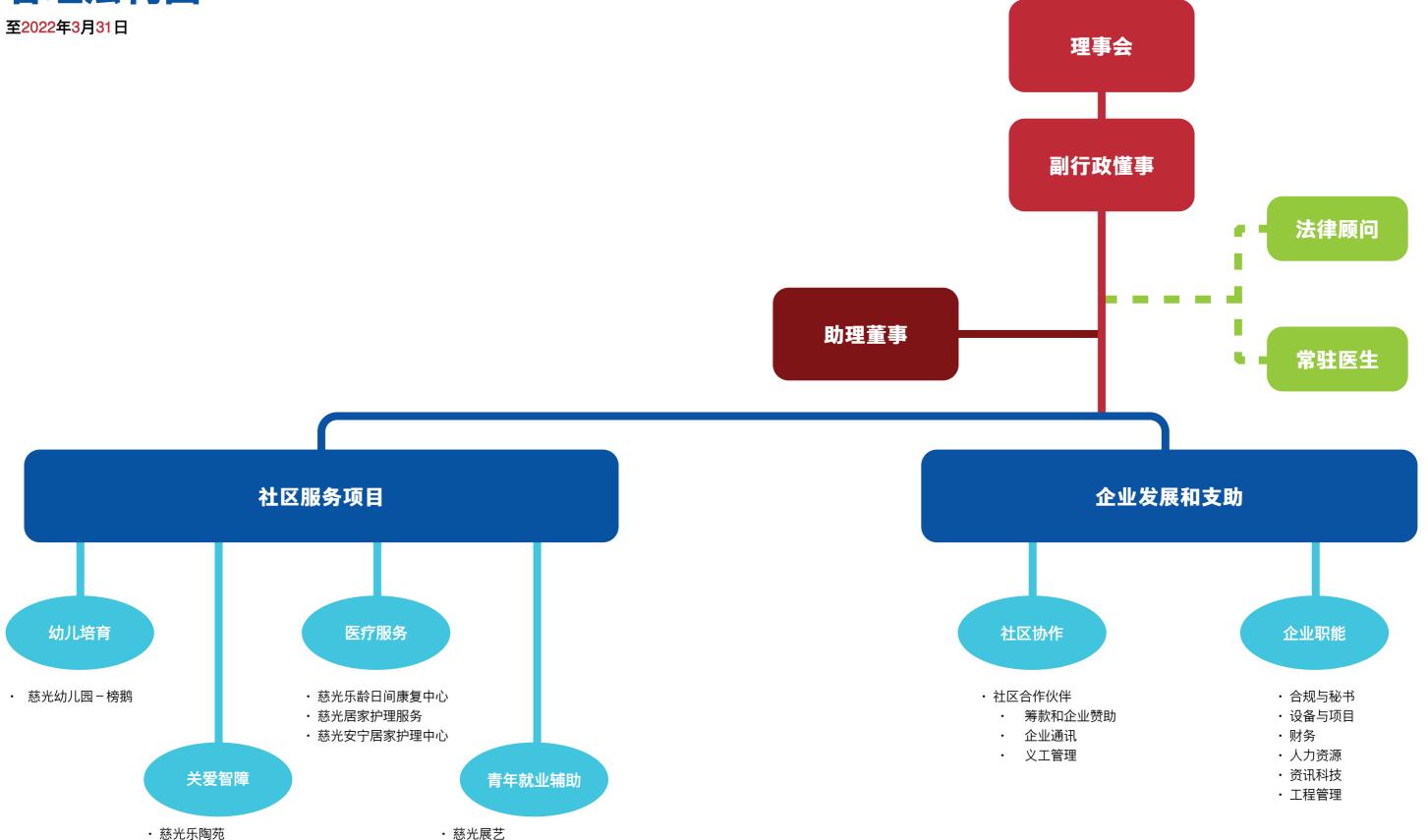

#### 专访 一 黄婉凌女士

(苏俊翰和苏紫宁的母亲)

大家好,我是婉凌 — 俊翰(6岁)和紫宁(3岁)的母亲。俊翰近日诊断出患有轻微自闭症,而紫宁目前受紧密观察。

当俊翰一岁半开始上幼儿班时,我发现他在言语发展方面落于人后。因此,他被转介到竹脚妇幼医院评估他的发育标志。医生建议我们延迟他报读小学,直到他培养了语言表达能力。

我们与俊翰的经历使我们更警觉的观察紫宁。我们发现紫宁和俊翰有相似的行为,所以在她一岁时带她到竹脚妇幼医院做评估。根据医生的建议,我们让紫宁报读婴儿与幼儿早期介入计划。

这一路走来不容易,但我们很欣慰看到俊翰自从上了慈光幼儿园在全方位学习和行为上的巨大进步。通过老师们的指导,他让他学会控制情绪和适应日常程序上的变化。以前的他如果在日常里需要做一些小变化,必定感到非常困难。但现在的他能以微小的抗拒和挣扎接受变化。

看着他在放学后等待我接他时,能和朋友们一同玩耍,他的进步,让我很欣慰。他和我分享学校里的 点滴以及和朋友们的互动,加强了我们母子的感情。

紫宁正在学习控制她的分离焦虑障碍。现在的她比较能忍受我无法时时刻刻陪在她的身边。随着她在 慈光幼儿园里接触交往和各种活动,她成功的克服了对噪音的恐惧。以前的她听见飞机声,就会大喊 大哭。但现在的她却能边跳舞边唱歌,差距真的太大了!

我期望俊翰和紫宁天天开心,健康成长。看着他们一天天在学习上、性格上和行为上成长,让我感到 无比的喜乐。

我非常感谢慈光全体老师们如此专业的教导和支持,让俊翰和紫宁克服种种困难,学习新知识。

我想鼓励有特殊需求孩子的父母,"专注于你孩子的需要。为他找寻适合他的支援。坚强的和你的孩子一起成长,一起学习。永不放弃!"

#### 专访 — 黄田羽先生 (21岁)

田羽3岁时被确诊患有自闭症。学习言语对许多孩子是自然,先 天的过程。但是,这对田羽是个很大的挑战性。他在加入慈光 学校一年后,在老师们的教导下才开始会言语。

在等待被入取慈光学校时,田羽在一所主流小学上课。课程学习对他而言非常困难。他也因着他的回声病况和薄弱的语言能力,无法和同辈们融洽的相处。

在田羽11岁时,开始在慈光学校上课。慈光学校的自闭症课程以老师与学生的低比率和良好结构课程让他在成长上受益不少。通过自闭症课程,他进步迅速,在2018年转到了职业培训计划。

田羽目前在修读工艺教育学院烘烤做法技能证书的最后一年,助于他往后在社会工作,也为他开创在工艺教育学院继续深造的机会。

现在的田羽能与他人流利的对话。他不再有回声病况,并可以和他人互动自如,在公共场合自信的言语。

田羽是位有礼貌的学生,天性乐观,也有积极的学习态度,所以赢得了他工地监督员们的极多夸赞。他们非常乐意在他职业训练时教导和支持他。

随着田羽即将获取工艺教育学院烘烤做法技能证书,他的志愿是当一名巴士长。我们为田羽在未来的日子献上我们最深的祝福!

#### 专访 — 林鼎旭先生(十七岁)

随着鼎旭确诊患有自闭症和轻微智力障碍,他在9岁时报读了慈光学校的自闭症课程。

在慈光学校,鼎旭学习个人管理,培养了他的沟通能力和社交能力。这几年以来,他在日常生活活动上逐渐学习独立处理。

鼎旭目前报读了就业途径计划,慢慢的从学校过境入职业领域,学习技能预备他日后踏入社会就业。他抱着乐观的态度,

非常积极的学习新技能。他能正面的接受批评,并不断地 努力与他人交流和互动,学习社会上务必的基本工作 礼仪。

鼎旭的母亲骄傲的分享,"鼎旭在慈光学校成长了很多。他目前独立许多,也能听从他人的指示。他的之我控制能力大大的进展了,也会极力和他人互动。"

# 专访 — Namira Binte Ismail 青年(31岁)

Namira患有轻微智力障碍。在慈光展艺培训课程的指导下,不断努力和坚持的她终于成为一位有潜力的艺术家。

因为Namira的智力障碍,她开始学习时无法集中精神完成她的 美术作品。在重重困难中,她努力保持正面精神,不断地提醒自 己,跟从指示,定时的完成作品。现在的Namira能创造出细腻的 美术作品,迷人的蜡染画,水彩画和精致的陶艺品。

通过就业培训课程,Namira逐渐的有信心表达自己,并参与了樟宜机场集团的艺术赋能计划,让她进一步培养对艺术的鉴赏力,也学习了讲故事的技能。



今天的Namira是位开朗的艺术家。她已学习了如何应对她的焦虑状况,与他人接触时也不再感到有压力。以她坚定的性格和艺术的天赋,她一定能实现梦想,成为一名大艺术家!

## 慈光聚缘轩

#### "Sacrifice Nothing Campaign" 公益筹款活动

"Sacrifice Nothing Campaign" 公益筹款活动的发起是为了响应2021年6月5日的世界环境日,并鼓励大众'喂饱饥饿'和'减少杀生'。

此活动在2021年6月至8月进行,由社会企业The Social Kitchen和素食餐饮品牌植卓肉匠 (The Vegetarian Butcher)合作支持慈光聚缘轩,为医院,慈善机构的前线工作者表达谢意。通过这项活动,我们在2021年6月份,艰难的冠状疫情时期,为前线工作者免费提供了五万份美味和营养的植物性汉堡。





为了庆祝2021年护士节,新加坡博彩公司分发了将近38,000包,由慈 光聚缘轩青年们烘烤的爱心饼干, 给我国的护士们, 为他们在疫情期 间的付出表达感谢。



去年的中秋节庆典与众不同,因为慈光聚缘轩和公立培群学校一起合作烘烤特制的培群月饼。由特制 的培群月饼模具制作,慈光聚缘轩的青年们也负责将月饼装入限量版的盒子。





为了帮助看护者更好规划他们的财务,我们举办了一系列的网上课程。他们从中学习立定财政目标, 评估每月家里所需的消费和根据他们目前的财务能力应付经济状况的方法。我们也为看护者们提供了 遗产规划的质询,让他们在这方面做更好的规划。

因患有自闭症,铭益无法用语言表达自己的情绪。这引发了他强烈的情绪反应,常会出现大喊大叫 或其他暴力行为。

毕业后,拥有工艺教育学院烘烤技能证书的他在一间零售面包店就业。可是,铭益在新环境里无法 控制情绪,所以好几次在工作时情绪失控。后来,铭益在2020年10月加入慈光聚缘轩。为了帮助 铭益更好管理情绪,培训师们投入了大量时间和耐心去了解他,同时观察他的优势和需要改进的范 围,并且不断的与他交谈,鼓励他用言语表达情绪。

铭益的培训师们也为他准备了按步程序和系统化的指示,以促进他的学习和持续性。培训师们也教 导他母亲如何在家协助他练习情绪管理技能。

在培训师们的指导下,铭益在管理负面情绪上有了很大的进展。他学习了新技能,并能够用言语来 表达情绪。我们期待铭益在慈光聚缘轩完成培训,回到职场上继续追求他成为一名专业烘烤师的梦 想。





#### **Moto Tiles**

我们的复建项目在去年开始使用Moto Tiles来提高受益者的功能性及自理能力。

Moto Tiles的设计像拼图一样,附带内置LED和压力传感器。我们的治疗员根据每位受益者的物理功能配合Moto Tiles以提高他们整体的平衡性和体力。

慈光乐陶苑和智障日间活动中心的受益者都认为Moto Tiles很有趣,也成为了他们最爱的活动之一。至今,已有85位受益者通过Moto Tiles的复建项目受益。

### Samsung Flip

随着冠状疫情的发展,户外集体活动被取消。通过Samsung Flip,我们把日常活动以线上方式,让受益者继续参与各项活动。

借助互动性数码活动挂图,我们为受益者开发了各项互动性游戏,例如,谜题解题,逻辑游戏和YouTube视频运动。我们也和不同企业和学校合作,融入了线上义工活动,例如,歌唱活动,舞蹈活动和讲故事活动。这让我们的受益者边玩边提高他们的专注力和思考能力。



#### **Omivista**

Omivista是一个趣味性和互动性的移动感应投影系统,可以在平面投射动态图像。易于使用和操作, 慈光乐陶苑和智障日间活动中心的受益者可以通过Omivista的感官活动和游戏,提高他们的动作和互动技能。

我们的受益者非常喜欢Omivista的五彩视觉投影和大自然声音,助于他们保持身心活跃。

#### 专访 一 陈雍明先生(37岁)

雍明是慈光乐陶苑的一名居民。他每日通过各项活动充实自己。从拼图到涂色活动或是与居民们的互动,我们的护理人员会尽可能让他拥有充实的每一天。

起初,雍明对治疗活动十分抗拒,在过程中往往会感到不自在。他喜欢留在自己的舒适区,待在熟悉的工作人员身边。每当接触到不熟悉的治疗人员,他会感到很紧张,所以拒绝配合治疗。

在治疗师的加油打气下,雍明逐渐敞开心扉,开始参与治疗活动。不仅如此,在治疗师的指示下,他天生的好奇心也推动着 他完成各项任务。

我们很庆幸看到雍明能简单的自理,如独立的吃饭和穿衣,听从我们治疗员工的指示。



#### 专访 一 李高松先生(43岁)



高松患有中度智力障碍。为了让他学习社交技能和独立自主,他的 父母让他加入慈光智障日间活动中心。

由于他生性害羞,加上较差的社交和沟通能力,他在和他人互动上面对困难。每当他感到恐惧或受到刺激时,他都以过度活跃和侵略性行为应对。

为了帮助高松更好的管理情绪和行为,我们的关怀团队根据高松的需要拟定了个人化的治疗方案。这几年以来,高松在情绪管理和日常行为有了极大的进展。

Ghani先生充满感情的分享他母亲健在时的回忆。他鼓励其他看护者,"呼吸。保持坚强。开怀接受帮助和支持。紧紧的抓住爱。相信神必赐予你平安,力量和福气。记得亲口告诉你的亲人你爱他们,也及时寻求他们的原谅。"

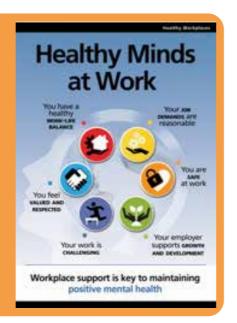

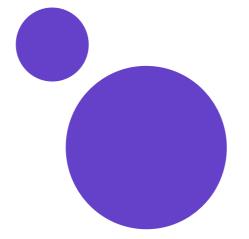

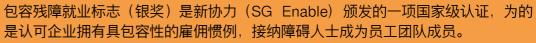

# **Management Committee**

# **Strategic Planning**

The MC approves and reviews our Vision, Mission and Values to ensure that we stay relevant in relation to the changing environment and needs of the community. These are communicated to all stakeholders and the public through various platforms, including our annual report and corporate website. The MC regularly reviews and updates our strategic plans to ensure that our activities are in line with our objectives.

### **Financial Management and Control**

The MC and Finance Committee jointly review and approve the annual budget prepared by the management team. Our charity's operating and capital expenditure budget is regularly monitored to ensure prudent usage of funds.

We are committed to disclosing audited statements that give an accurate and fair review of our financial position, in accordance with the requirements specified by the authorities.

We have written procedures in place for financial matters in key areas, including procurement and controls, receipting, payment procedures, controls and system for the delegation of authority and limits of approval.

### **Risk Management and Internal Control**

We adopt a rigorous enterprise risk management framework and conduct annual International Organisation for Standardization (ISO) internal audits on key aspects of our operations. The Audit Committee assists the MC in providing risk management oversight, while the Senior Management Team monitors and ensures the integrity of the internal control systems.

We also engage independent internal and external auditors periodically to ensure that our internal controls are in place and that our financial, investment and fundraising policies are well-adhered to. The findings and recommendations made by the internal and external auditors are reviewed by the Audit Committee and reported to the MC.

# **Fundraising Practices**

We have established guidelines on fundraising based on the best practices set by the National Council of Social Services (NCSS) and the Charity Council. All donations collected are clearly recorded and properly accounted for.

# **Conflict of Interest Policy**

We have clear policies and procedures in place to manage and avoid situations of conflict of interest. All MC members, Sub-Committee members and our staff are required to make declarations of conflict of interest at the start of their terms or at the point of hire, annually and at the first point of such conflict or as soon as a conflict or potential conflict arises. In any matter where a conflict of interest exists, the conflicted individual(s) are not allowed to vote and/or participate in the decision-making process pertaining to the matter.

# **Reserves Policy**

We maintain a level of reserves to ensure long-term financial sustainability. We maintain maximum reserves level of up to 5 years of annual operating expenditure. Our reserves exclude all Building/Project Fund, Endowment and Sinking Fund.

### **Whistle-Blowing Policy**

We are committed to the highest standards of honesty, transparency, accountability, ethical and integrity conduct. We have a whistle-blowing policy in place to provide an avenue for our employees, volunteers, beneficiaries and any external parties to raise genuine concerns about suspected improprieties without having to fear reprisal.

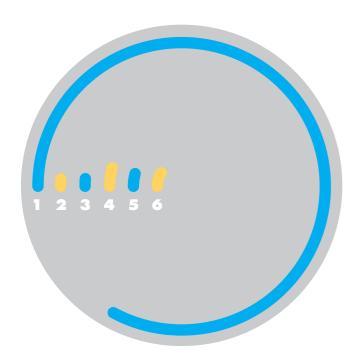

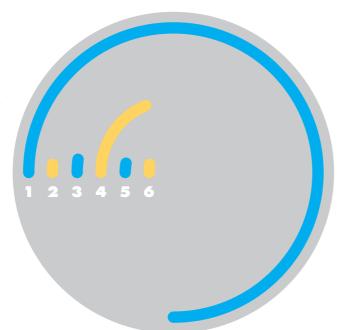
